

POST RESULTS – APPEALS AND GUIDANCE

As a result of the disruption to the education of students caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the UK government determined that it would not be possible to hold examinations in summer 2021 in a way which would be perceived to be fair.

As a result of this decision a consultation process and a subsequent general framework on how students would be awarded grades was published by Ofqual.

If you request a centre review or an awarding organisation appeal there are three possible outcomes:

- Your original grade is lowered, so your final grade will be lower than the original grade you received.
- Your original grade is confirmed, so there is no change to your grade.
- Your original grade is raised, so your final grade will be higher than the original grade you received.

Once a finding has been made you cannot withdraw your request for a centre review or appeal. If your grade has been lowered you will not be able to revert back to the original grade you received on results day.

3 September 2021 for non-priority appeals.
